



Port St. Lucie Hospital is located on 20 acres near the beautiful Savannas Preserve and provides a tranquil retreat-like environment for our patients.


Twenty-four hour care is provided by licensed professionals.

DUAL DIAGNOSIS PROGRAM

The Dual Diagnosis Program at Port St. Lucie Hospital provides treatment for co-occurring chemical dependency and mental health issues in an inpatient setting. Psychiatrist lead the treatment team to assure quality patient care.

THE TREATMENT TEAM CONSISTS OF:

- An Attending Psychiatrist
- Licensed Therapists
- Psychiatric Nurses
- Mental Health Technicians
- Medical Consultants

Our patients meet with members of their treatment team at least three times weekly to ensure the best possible treatment for the individual's own specific needs.

The treatment team works with each individual to develop an individualized treatment plan. The treatment plan is reviewed and revised by the treatment team and the patient at least once per week.

The attending psychiatrist closely supervises medication management.

The program provides mental health and addiction education classes to meet each patient's specific needs and group therapies on a daily basis. Individual and family therapies are highly encouraged and are provided by our therapists.

- Psychological Testing - (Per doctor's orders)
- Psycho-education groups
